**No. 48/2011**

In a bail application for the grant of anticipatory bail related to a case u/s 406/498 IPC, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi had observed that while opposing the bail application of the husband and other collateral accused such as father-in-law, mother-in-law, brother-in-law or sister-in-law etc. before the Session court, the Investigation Officer/SHO does not disclose whether prior approval of the DCP concerned has been obtained on file or otherwise resulting in adverse orders on the submission of the Public Prosecutor and I.O.s that their custodial interrogation is required.

Henceforth, all SHOs/I.O.s investigating the cases u/s 406/498A IPC may please be directed to invariably mention in the Report/Status report filed before the Session Court that approval of the DCP concerned has been obtained/not obtained as prescribed in SO No.330 dated 8.10.2008.

The above instructions/points may be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance. Non compliance of the instructions will be viewed seriously.
