Subject: - Regarding Meeting held on 6.7.2017 to discuss preparedness and action taken for Dengue and Chikungunya at Raj Niwas under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble L.G., Delhi.

Memo.

I am directed to intimate that Spl. CP/Hdqrs. & Rectt., Delhi and undersigned attended a meeting on 6.7.2017 at Raj Niwas, Delhi under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble L.G., Delhi regarding preparedness and action taken for Dengue and Chikungunya. The basic focus of the meeting was: -

1. To step up the action already initiated for the prevention of vector borne diseases i.e. Dengue, Chikungunya and Malaria etc.
2. Hon'ble L.G., Delhi has directed that mass awareness programme regarding prevention of Dengue and Chikungunya should be held with the community. They should be educated and made aware through leaflets, hoardings etc. He has also desired a weekly report in this regard.

In order to ensure the compliance of the Hon'ble L.G.'s direction, the action on the following points may be taken and compliance report be sent to this Headquarters **on every Monday** by the District/Unit DCsP without fail so that consolidated report could be sent to Secretary to the Hon'ble L.G., Delhi on weekly basis: -

- a. Extensive door to door campaigning should be held in Delhi Police colonies by respective RWAs.
- b. Districts/Units DCsP may get pamphlet/leaflets printed and get it distributed through RWAs. Sample of the pamphlet may be had from Directorate of Health Services, Govt. of N.C.T., Delhi.
- c. Dos & Don'ts Big Hoardings displaying the preventive action to be taken to be put up in the colonies.
- d. Liaison may be made with civic agencies in enacting education hoarding in all establishments of Delhi Police residential colonies.

- e. Continuous checking of stagnant water in various case properties lying in open by one of the Inspector in police station as well as traffic establishment & P&L, PCR and all such units.
- f. The Estate Officers of the Colonies to hold meetings with the RWAs & ensure that required action to prevent the incidents of vector borne disease is taken.
- g. Case properties lying in open area in Police Stations be checked daily by the A.T.O. & Malkhana Head Constable to ensure that there is no water stagnant at these sites. SHOs/ACsP to monitor it on daily basis.
- h. Spl. C.P. Welfare may also held meeting with the Estate Officers of the Districts/Units in this regard.
