**Subject: Mosquito menace- Dengue/ Chikungunya.**

Please refer to our letter No. 1445-150/P.Sec.Spl CP/Welfare & EOS dated 22.07.2015 & 2157-2225/P.Sec.Spl CP/Welfare & EOS dated 24.09.2015 in addition to PRO's letter No.1256-66/PRO/PHQ dated 02.08.2016 on the aforesaid subject.

As you are aware, there is a steep rise in the number of dengue/chikungunya cases all over the city in recent days. These are preventable through a planned approach (both short term/long term), surveillance, knowledge and awareness of early signs. Elimination of breeding sites, anti larval measures and personal protection will help prevent any outbreak. Community mobilisation, coordination with civic authorities in mosquito control measures like fogging, prompt and proper removal of garbage, focus on stagnant waters, vector control and general cleanliness are crucial in containment of these diseases. Preparedness and rapid response on the part of Estate and Welfare staff in particular and other concerned offices is important. Educational activity and effective communication through resident associations as well as leaders of units are also critical in preventing the undesirable consequences of the epidemic. An immediate anti-mosquito survey and preventive campaign should be launched in every colony. The weekly Swachh Bharat programme should be strengthened and all members be involved in anti-dengue/chikungunya activities.

Heads of unit/districts are required to ensure proper coordination, survey, monitoring and evaluation of anti-mosquito measures being taken by personal example and commitment to excellence in implementation of various measures.
