**AMENDMENT IN SO NO.03/2015**

Estates Officer have been functioning in Districts/Units for the past few years. They look after upkeep and maintenance of police colonies and police buildings. They also interact with resident associations regularly. A number of issues relating to welfare are intertwined with one issue or the other of maintenance/repair of quarters. It is felt that widening the scope of role of Estate Officers by inclusion of issues of welfare in his/her charter of duties may provide for better addressing of the twin issues apart from reinforcing the hands of DCP in proper management of grievance redressal mechanism of units/districts. This apart, they can help in fostering of social and cultural activities for members and their families, improved attention to recreation and sports facilities for staff and assistance to staff in health and related matters.

In view of the above, the following amendment is made in the Standing Order No.03/2015 (Regarding Allotment of Residential Accommodation on the Charge of the Delhi Police), issued vide OB No.35/2015 or No.5533-5843/RB/PHQ, dated 01.09.2015:-
