As you are aware, improvements in welfare have been made in the recent past with regular holding of Sampark Sabhas, meeting of personnel by ACsP at individual level and upgradation of role Estate Officers as of Estate-cum-Welfare Officers and the like. It is possible that certain problems of humanitarian nature expressed by personnel may escape attention in the routine process. Officers at different levels in the chain of command need to be extra alert and sensitive about such exceptional cases. In one such case, the Commissioner of Police has come across the representation of wife of a member seeking transfer from one unit to another as two of their young children are mentally handicapped.

In the light of above, you may take personal note of such cases and ensure that they are properly reported and followed up for proper redressal of the same.
